All Scouts must have an adult partner present at camp. One adult can partner with up to **two Cub Scouts or three Webelos Scouts**.

Please refer to the consent form for the responsibilities of the adult partner.

Each Scout must have the adult partner listed on his registration form, though the adult partner pays the fee with only one form. More than one adult may attend with a Scout. Webelos may attend as a Den. This is a great way for Webelos Dens to practice camping.

Deposit: \$50/person is due with the registration form.

Full Payment is due by: May 25, 2012.

The late fee is an additional \$25 per person if fee is paid in full AFTER May 27, 2012. Registrations received after May 25, 2012, will be accepted on a space-available-basis.
