WHAT YOU CAN DO AT CAMP

The best thing to beat the heat in space is a dip in our famous Navarro River. There's nothing better to do at camp than experience nature first hand. Visit the **nature area** and learn about the local plants and animals, make your own animal track, and become a Navarro Naturalist! Everyone loves a nature space walk. These are offered guided by a staff member or self-guided at your convenience. But don't forget to take a buddy!

Climbing Wall!* Climb 26 feet up in the air and take in a "bird's eye view" of Camp Masonite Navarro! A view not too many people have had. Increase your technical climbing skills or get a short sample of climbing on the camp's traversing wall. Parents, too!

What can you do at camp Cubs and Scouts can't do just anywhere? **BB Guns and archery!** The Boy Scouts of America has the highest standard of safety in training youth in shooting sports safety. Learn the basics about traditional target archery or try your aim at on our field archery course.* For Boy Scout age and adult campers, the .22 rifle range and shot gun shooting* is available. No one wants to miss the black-power demonstration!

For your convenience, the Masonite Navarro **Trading Post** is open after breakfast and past dessert. Find Scouting gear and camping treasures, Masonite Navarro mementos, and new special products! And don't forget the ice cream, sno-cones, and snacks.

Camp wouldn't be complete without a camp-wide **campfire!** The one-of-a-kind Masonite Navarro staff will take you on an adventure with songs, skits, and stories. This is always a highlight of camp! Numerous other activities available for everyone such as volleyball, horseshoes, craft activities, outdoor skills, orienteering with a GPS or a map & compass, games and much, much more! And yes it's OK to lay under a tree, read a book, or just relax in the beauty of camp.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Choose between sleeping in adirondacks (3-sided structure with a roof, sleeps 8) on bunk beds, or bring your own tent to pitch. Gear will need to be carried into your campsite; a camp truck will be available for larger bulky items as needed. Cabins (7 people/cabin) are available for an extra fee (space is limited). If someone in your party requires special accommodations, please notify the Council Service Center as soon as possible so we can offer everyone the best experience possible.

MEALS

Meals are served in our dining hall. Breakfast is at 8 AM, lunch is at noon and dinner is served at 6 PM.

Weather: Every attempt, within common safety guidelines, is made to offer the full outdoor program each day. Special "rainy day" program features may be substituted for some activities if the weather warrants it. Regardless, all programs will take place rain or shine. Refunds are not available due to inclement weather unless the camp is cancelled.
