



Thank you for your interest in the Redwood Regional Challenge (RRC). We believe that this is a wonderful opportunity to showcase Scouting to our community. **We will have a meeting for all attending Units on January 24th at the Scout office from 6pm-8pm. Additional details will be provided and questions**

answered. It is recommended that each unit send one or more person for this meeting. Each unit will need to support the RCC with adult/older scout volunteers in the area of Logistics, Program and Leave No Trace Champions.

The RRC kick off will consist of all of the activities below happening at the eight selected Sonoma County Regional Parks (SCRP) on the same day.

For Boy Scouts the weekend will begin Friday evening 4/21 camping at their selected park.

For Cub Scouts the day of the event (4/22) will consist of a service project supporting the RRC trails and other Scouting activities. The morning and early afternoon Saturday will be spent with all Scouts completing these service projects. The remainder of the afternoon will be spent teaching/doing Scout skill activities similar to the activities done at Camporee. The evening will consist of a campfire program with Boy Scouts and Webelos camping Saturday night. A Scouts Own service will follow breakfast Sunday morning. Dinner Friday, Lunch and dinner Saturday, breakfast Sunday for campers, will be Jamboree style **provided and organized within each Scouting unit.**

This special event kicking off the ongoing RRC program will be brought to you at a very minimal cost per scout and leader.

Sign ups are by the Unit. If a Scouts Unit is not participating we will match the Scout up with a Unit that is. There is room for other "out of the District" units to sign up also. All are welcome!

The Council Program Committee feels that establishing this trail system is unique opportunity that is worth the effort. With the excepting of the service project this event will be similar to our Camporee. Camporee will be offered by the District Camping Committees in the future.

There are opportunities to do Eagle projects at each of these parks. John Ryan of SCRCP will be coordinating these projects. If this looks like something you want to do, we can connect you and John. It is our desire to have an eagle project at each of the parks on this day.
